

DERBY RULES

- \$10.00 entry fee for all ages
- Derby starts at 7:00 a.m. when horn goes off—NO LINES SHALL BE PUT IN THE WATER UNTIL THE START OF THE DERBY. Derby ends at 12:00 noon when horn goes off.
- All anglers must comply with Massachusetts Fish & Wildlife Laws.
- Prizes for the heaviest Bass, Pickerel and Yellow Perch
- Bass and Pickerel must be legal length to enter
- No one shall enter more fish than creel limit allows
- Weight at time of entry determines winners. In case of a tie, the length shall be the determinate factor for Pickerel and Perch. Earliest entry will be the final tiebreaker and only tiebreaker for Bass.
- ALL BASS MUST BE KEPT ALIVE (PAIL OF WATER) AND RELEASED IMMEDIATELY AT YOUR HOLE OR AFTER WEIGH IN.
- ALL FISH MUST BE WEIGHED IN BEFORE END OF DERBY. ABSOLUTELY NO FISH WILL BE WEIGHED IN AFTER CLOSING HORN GOES OFF.
- Prize money will come from the entry fee, split three ways. All entries must be weighed on scale supplied by the Fitchburg Sportsmen's Club Fish & Game Committee (FSCFGC) and only by an authorized FSCFGC person.
- The FSCFGC has the final say on any ruling or decisions.
